- Buy your uniform. You need khaki pants, formal shoes and a formal belt. Detailed information is in the handbook. Make this as dressy as possible. There is an explanation of [jeans vs. khaki pants](#) on the website.
- Everyone has to bring in their uniform for inspection at the beginning of each year. Check the website for uniform inspection dates. No pictures will be accepted. If you ever buy anything new, it needs to be inspected and approved.
- Order your navy blue Chorus Polo Shirt. The form can be found on the website. If you need a new chorus shirt, you may order a new one or trade your shirt for a used one in our inventory. If your size is not available, then you will have to order a new one.
- You don't have to buy your music, but you may want to keep your copy and buy a replacement for the choral library. You can place an order with LMMS PTSA. Fill out the form and turn in your form and your money to the school store or a black payment box. Students are responsible for writing in their music in pencil and returning a clean copy. If you don't want to erase and worry about the condition of the music, you might just spend the two or three dollars and keep your own copy. More information about buying music is in the handbook.
